President's Message -Ted Brengel-

(Let me start by mentioning the D-6 Night Market, which was held on Saturday, May 18. MMTC had a booth, of course. It seemed to be that the event was bigger and better than ever. I hope some of our members got a chance to enjoy it. It was absolutely worth stopping by.

Two things I always forget to mention are the Community Leaders Forum and the Captain's Advisory Board. First, the Community Leader's Forum or CLF. This is a monthly meeting at MCAS Miramar led by the people from the Community Plans and Liaison Office, currently headed by Kristin Camper who often attends our MMTC meetings. At these meetings we review recent noise complaints, get briefed on changes in aircraft inventory and squadrons present, and any other events at MCAS Miramar which might be of interest. Let me mention at this point that there is a belief held by some that pilots sometimes act without discretion in the route they fly and their use of excess power. That is mostly myth because each aircraft is under the control of the FAA Air Traffic Control Center as soon as its wheels leave the ground. Speed, altitude and path are very strictly controlled, so usually the aircraft pilot has very little discretion in these matters. Nonetheless, the Operations Department at MCAS Miramar takes each complaint very seriously and investigates to make certain that all rules are being followed.

The other meeting I regularly attend is the Captain's Advisory Board. This is a meeting held by the leader of the Northeastern Division of our Police Department, which is currently Captain Christopher Knighten, a 23-year SDPD veteran. At these meetings community representatives from Northeastern Division Communities hear about any changes in department policy, or community events or trends that have come to police attention. It is also an opportunity for us to ask questions about current events or recent criminal activity. These can be very interesting sessions.
