 - i) September 29th hearing
 - ii) CEQA does not consider economic factors
 - iii) Jeff Stevens – How is adding on to existing transmission lines visually impactful? There is a visual impact study
 - iv) Who gave the feedback of going through PQ canyon? It was determined that of the 44 options studied, route 5 had the least obstructions
 - v) Jeff Stevens – Skepticism about environmental feasibility

 - (2) 40 years is a long time and current SANDAG plan does not take into account of new technologies, e.g. self driving cars

 - c) San Diego Pure Water program - Jeff Soriano and Brent Eidson
 - i) Phase 1 is North City which links to Miramar Reservoir

 - (3) Can water and SDGE be in same trench? No
